Waiting times for treatment at Walsall Manor Hospital. Also patient had 6 appointments cancelled.

Pregnant mum wanting vitamins but GP no longer prescribing. Signposted to Healthy Options to get.

Dyslexic patient has difficulty using GP online booking system.

Patient comment about usefulness of NHS111. Their advise to monitor issue could have caused serious condition.

Caller wanted to know where COVID19 top up vaccinations were in Walsall. 119 could not tell them.
