## Issues and Themes for September 2024

- Patient had p.m. appointment booked at Urology Department. Waited half hour to be told consultant was sick in the morning and did not come in.
- Lack of awareness around dementia support in Walsall.
- Staff attitude in GP practice an issue.
- From visit to Walsall Urology services patients feel there is poor communication for them between the shared service at Walsall Manor Hospital and New Cross appointment booking.
- Patient told different things by Walsall Manor Hospital staff.
- GP advising patient to wait with lump under arm. Went private and told a cyst, needs treatment.
