Our Engagement for January

We attended over 26 events out in the various communities of Walsall and engaged with 206 people.

We have 3,390 Social media followers across our various social media platforms.

We had 907 visitors to our website, of which 727 were new visitors who viewed 3,700 pages in total .

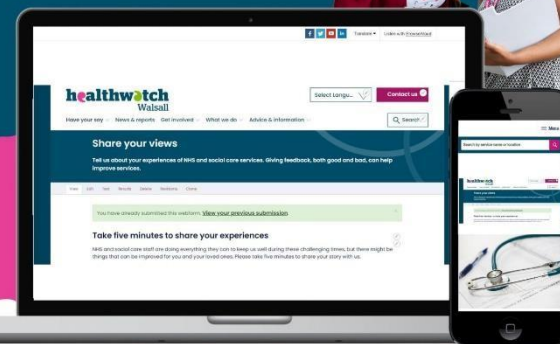

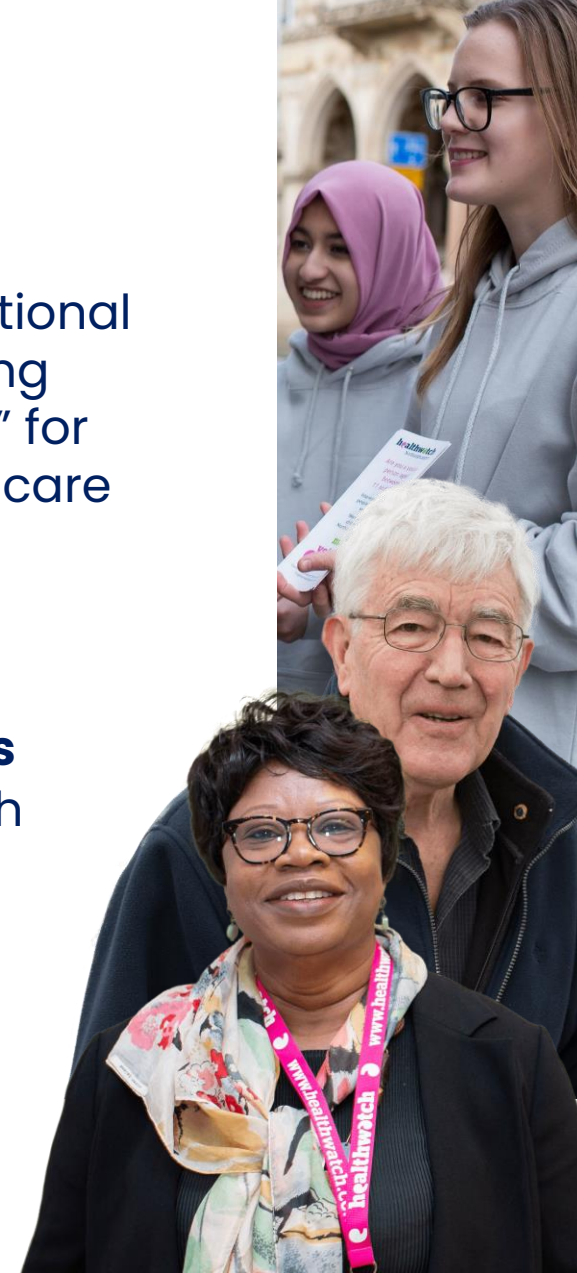
